

## **Radiation Management Land Disposal of Low Level Radioactive Waste**

A license is required for the land disposal of low level radioactive waste. The specific technical requirements for near surface disposal of less than thirty meters of this material are outlined in Part 14 of the Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control.

### **Who Must Apply**

Any person who wants to receive, possess or dispose of low level radioactive waste at a land disposal facility must be licensed.

### **Duration of License**

The license is terminated upon the full implementation of the approved final closure plan. The authority to dispose waste expires on the date stated in the license and is variable depending on the size of the approved facility.

### **Fees**

The fees charged will be used on the actual full cost of processing the application at an hourly rate of \$85 per hour.

### **Application Process**

Application - file one year prior to construction of project  
Renewal Application - file one year prior to license expiration  
Closure Application - file one year prior to license expiration

### **Public Involvement**

There are no public participation requirements.
