



Notice of Waste Grease Registration, Fees, and Financial Assurance

New Solid Waste regulations require transporters of waste grease (yellow grease or trap grease), facilities that collect, store, process, or dispose of waste grease, and individuals who collect or transport waste grease for personal use (other than for use as biofuel) to register with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (the Department). [6 CCR 1007-2, Part 1 Section 18 (the Regulations), effective January 30, 2012; authorized by §30-20-113, et seq. of the Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.)]

Registration Process

Waste grease transporters, facilities, and personal users of waste grease other than for use as biofuel must register with the Department starting January 30, 2012 and annually thereafter. The Waste Grease Certificate of Registration Application form (Form WG-1) is available at www.cdphe.state.co.us/hm/wastegrease. Form WG-1 must be completed either electronically or by hand, signed with an original signature, and mailed to the address listed on the form along with a check for the appropriate annual fee(s) (listed in the box below).

Waste grease transporters and personal users of waste grease other than for use as biofuel must indicate the number of vehicles they use to transport waste grease on Form WG-1 and provide for each vehicle used a legible copy of the current vehicle registration. If the vehicle is not owned by the waste grease transporter or personal user, also include written authorization from the vehicle owner for the vehicle to be registered to transport waste grease. If the vehicle has a tank to store waste grease, provide the size or capacity of the tank.

If the waste grease transporter contracts with a commercial freight carrier to transport waste grease on the waste grease transporter's behalf, indicate that commercial freight carrier temporary decals are needed by checking the box provided.

Fees and Financial Assurance

The appropriate annual fee(s) must be submitted with the completed and signed Form WG-1. Please note that you may have to pay more than one fee (e.g., waste grease facility annual fee and waste grease transporter per vehicle fee if both of these registration categories apply). The Department will not process Form WG-1 without the appropriate fee(s). Make checks payable to CDPHE or Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

Waste grease transporters must include the annual fee amount for each vehicle used by the transporter to transport waste grease. If the waste grease transporter also contracts with a commercial freight carrier to transport waste grease on the waste grease transporter's behalf, the waste grease transporter must include the commercial freight carrier temporary decal fee.

Waste grease transporters and waste grease facilities must acquire financial assurance in accordance with Section 1.8 of the Regulations **within ninety (90) days of your registration application approval**. **Waste grease transporters** must acquire and maintain financial assurance in the amount of \$10,000 for third party cleanup and proper disposal of waste grease. **Waste grease facilities** must obtain financial assurance in the amount of third party reclamation and closure cost estimates, as described in Section 1.8 of the regulations.
