

Pursuant to C.R.S. 24-4-103(6), the State Board of Health will hold an emergency rulemaking hearing to consider the repeal of 5 CCR 1006-2, Regulation 2(A)(iii) (definition of "significant responsibility for managing the well-being of a patient.") to remove the rule's conflict with the Colorado Court of Appeals decision in People v. Clendenin, No. 08CA0624 (Colo. Ct. App., October 29, 2009). A copy of the proposed rule and emergency justification is attached.
