3:00 Introduction

In response to comments from stakeholders and EPA, APCD staff will propose a draft alternative proposal to that which was presented to the Air Quality Control Commission at the September 18, 2008 Request for Hearing on the Ozone Action Plan. APCD staff will also explain the reasoning behind the changes. APCD staff will focus on specific regulations for oil & gas and stationary sources and summarize the next key milestones in the rulemaking process.

3:30 Review of Regulation Changes

Specific to the draft alternative proposal, APCD staff will summarize the changes compared to the original proposed rule language, summarize any changes regarding which strategies are incorporated into the SIP and State-only rule making packages, and provide draft language for Regulations 3 and 7. These changes are specific to:

- Condensate Tank Recordkeeping and Reporting
- RICE
- Pneumatics
- Exemptions
- Reg 3/7 RACT

Note: The draft language presented at this meeting will be posted on the APCD's ozone website on November 6, 2008. The APCD's alternative proposal may be revised as a result of this stakeholder meeting. Any revisions will be incorporated into the alternative proposal and circulated to all formal rulemaking parties on November 13, 2008, with the APCD prehearing statement.
