

**Colorado Smoke Management Program - Priorities  
For the second half of 2011  
Colorado Air Pollution Control Division**

[Note to external readers: This is a list of priorities, not necessarily of expected accomplishments. We write out a longer list than we expect to complete. In past half-years we've got half to two-thirds of the way down lists like this one.]

1. Website migration to Colorado Interactive hosting.
2. Make progress implementing community-based pilot project initiative.
3. Host semi-annual stakeholder meeting.
4. Review permit applications and revision requests in  $\leq 30$  days, including internal committee review of some non-standard applications.
5. On-line reporting:
  - a. Complete database update including forms.
  - b. Create draft InfoPath form. Use it to explore short-term hosting options and 'proof-of-concept'.
6. Finalize memo defining ag burning.
7. Work with The Nature Conservancy on a modeling workshop.
8. Make site visits & inspections, with reports, for a few high-priority burn days and/or people.
9. Set up mechanism to monitor revenue collection & minimize inappropriate diversions to collections.
