SUBJECT: Sarsfield Foods Ltd., Pumpkin Pies

Sarsfield Foods Ltd., Kentville, Nova Scotia, has developed a pumpkin pie that has been formulated to be stable at room temperature. This is a standardized formulation and will be the only one used to manufacture this pie.

The subject pie is not deemed to be a potentially hazardous food as defined in the "Rules and Regulations Governing the Sanitation of Food Service Establishments in the State of Colorado" and the "Rules and Regulations Governing the Sanitation of Retail Food Establishments in the State of Colorado."

The pie will be manufactured in three sizes and the bottom of the pie tin will be embossed with the following product codes:

8" Product Code #16123

9" Product Code #47923

10" Product Code #61223
