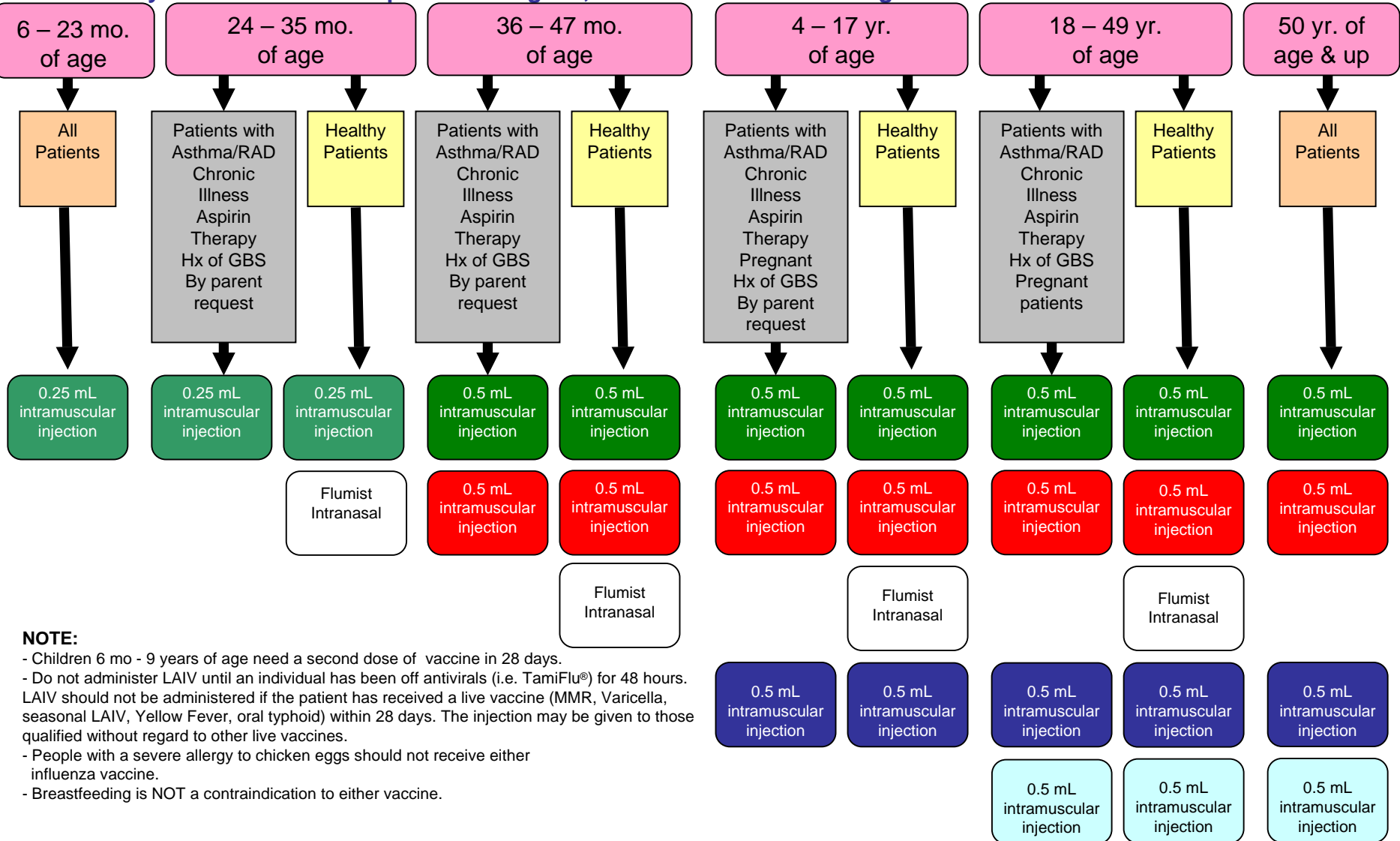


2009 H1N1 Vaccination Clinic

Once you've determined a person is eligible, decide which vaccine to give based on the information below.



NOTE:

- Children 6 mo - 9 years of age need a second dose of vaccine in 28 days.
- Do not administer LAIV until an individual has been off antivirals (i.e. TamiFlu®) for 48 hours. LAIV should not be administered if the patient has received a live vaccine (MMR, Varicella, seasonal LAIV, Yellow Fever, oral typhoid) within 28 days. The injection may be given to those qualified without regard to other live vaccines.
- People with a severe allergy to chicken eggs should not receive either influenza vaccine.
- Breastfeeding is NOT a contraindication to either vaccine.

 	 	 	 	 	 
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
