Colorado Immunization Program (CIP) American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Requests for Application 2009-10



Beginning October 1, 2009, the Colorado Immunization Program (CIP) incorporated American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) resources into programming to increase the number of children and adults vaccinated against vaccine-preventable diseases.

The CIP is utilizing the ARRA funds to enhance existing strategies that have been shown to be effective in raising immunization coverage and reducing vaccine-preventable disease (VPD) morbidity and mortality. Through local government, community-vaccinators, and partners CIP is also engaging in innovative strategies to reach populations not currently being reached.

The six CIP ARRA-funded projects are as follows:

1. Metro Area Food-Safety Pilot
2. Tdap Cocooning Project Expansion
3. Vaccination and Orientation of Allied Health Students
4. Vaccination of College/University Students for Meningitis and Tdap
5. Zoster Vaccine Pilot
6. Increasing Vaccination Innovative Project
