Deliverable	Funding	HHS Target Area	Information
800 MHz Drills	4 drills / \$500 per drill = \$2,000	Interoperable Communication	Funding will be released upon receipt of letter confirming participation in drills. Drills will be conducted by CDPHE-HPP.
IS-100 Course	2 certificates / \$250 per certificate = \$500	NIMS	Funding will be released upon verification/certificate of 2 staff, within the ICS Command Structure of the facility, taking the IS-100 course. If the IS-700 course was not taken and reimbursed in the last round of funding, 2 IS-700 certificates will have to be submitted for this round of funding. <b><u>CRITICAL: We will not be able to reimburse you for the other deliverables unless this NIMS training is completed and submitted.</u></b>
Healthcare coalition or MOU	\$500	Partnership/Coalition Development	Funding will be released upon receipt of healthcare coalition meeting minutes or written MOU with an community partner. Healthcare coalition/MOU should contain member/s from Public Health, EMS, Emergency Management, CVM Administrator, Local Clinics, MRC (MOU will only be accepted if with an <b>outside</b> entity and not physically a part of your clinic)
Exercise	\$1,000	Exercise, Evaluations and Corrective Actions	Funding will be released upon receipt of written summary/detail for an internal exercise/drill (not one of the drills being held by CDPHE) involving at least two areas of preparedness. Examples would be: use of 800MHz radios, involving community MOU's, fatality management, medical evacuation, or testing of some aspect of your facility's EOP. The Exercise/Drill must have taken place between 7-1-10 & 4-30-11.
Integration & Installation of EMSsystem	\$500 x 2 clinic employees = \$1,000	Tracking of Bed Availability and Hospital Facility Situational Awareness	Funding will be released upon verification of participation of two or more <b>clinic employees</b> in a CoTrain (online) course titled Introduction to EMSsystem. Information will be provided at a later date once this online course has been made available.
