

QIS Provider Information

-Immediately upon survey entrance, the surveyors will request an **alphabetical resident census** list with room numbers/units. Please note any residents who are not in the facility (e.g. in the hospital).

-Immediately upon survey entrance, the surveyors will provide a **new admission information form**. List all new admissions after the date listed (the 30-day period prior to the survey) on the form. **Include only residents still residing in the facility**. Include admission date, date of birth, and room number/unit.

-Within one hour of entrance, the surveyors will request the name of the resident council president or an active council member.

-Within four hours of entrance, the surveyors will request a worksheet that lists residents who receive PASRR level two services, ventilator, dialysis, and end of life services.

-During stage one, the surveyors will be review resident medical records. A six-month weight history is part of this review. Please have the weight records accessible for this record review.

-During stage one, floor nurse interviews will be conducted. One question asked is whether the resident has fallen or sustained a fracture in the last 30 days. It may be helpful to have this information accessible to the nurses, without having to read a month's worth of nurse's notes.
