

AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTER FEES

² ASC remodeling fees apply to significant modifications which include new construction, relocation of walls of any room, addition of one or more rooms, changes to fire alarm system involving replacement of main fire alarm control unit; and modifications to the medical gas system affecting 50% or more of the facility.

³ Replacement building costs include the cost associated with an initial plan review as well as \$600 for license processing changes.
