

## DIALYSIS TREATMENT CLINIC FEES

General licensing and technician fees are established in regulation, 6 CCR 1011-1, Chapter II, section 2.20 and Chapter XV, section 3. In addition, Section 13-64-301 (4), C.R.S., specifies the applicable fee under the Health Care Availability Act (HCAA). The table below details the fees.

Section 3.1: Effective January 1, 2009, each dialysis treatment clinic shall submit with its application for initial licensure or relicensure an annual fee of \$200 to cover the department's administrative costs in implementing these rules. The \$200 fee shall be in addition to any licensing fee established pursuant to Section 25-3-105, C.R.S.
