

The **Radiation Advisory Committee** is created under Title 25, Article 11, Section 105(1) of the Colorado Revised Statutes. The Statute states:

“The governor shall appoint a radiation advisory committee of nine members, no more than four of whom shall represent any one political party and three of whom shall represent industry, three the healing arts, and three of the public and private institutions of higher education. Members of the committee shall serve at the discretion of the governor and shall be reimbursed for necessary and actual expenses incurred in the attendance at meetings or for authorized business of the board. The committee shall furnish to the department such technical advice as may be desirable or required on matters relating to the radiation control program.”
