The Radiation Management Unit of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has reviewed the Special Use Permit application dated July 22, 2008. This document presents a general overview of the project that would be the subject of a radioactive materials license application in the future if the project proceeds. The information presented here appears to provide a suitable overview consistent with what we would expect for a uranium recovery operation, and we have no specific comments at this time. Significantly greater detail will be required for the license application to us; however, as indicated in the document, additional studies and detailed designs are underway.
