Thank you for your correspondence dated July 31, 2009 (received by our office on August 5, 2009) regarding the subject project.


Based on the information provided, we concur with your determination that 5MN9206 is **eligible** for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). We concur with your determination that 5MN9207, 5MN9208, and 5MN9209 are **not eligible** for the NRHP. In addition, we concur that isolated finds 5MN9210 and 5MN9211 are **not eligible** for the NRHP.

As all cultural resources, regardless of eligibility, will be avoided by the proposed activities, we concur that a finding of **no historic properties affected** is appropriate for the proposed project.

Should unidentified archaeological resources be discovered during the course of the project, work must be interrupted until the resources have been evaluated in terms of the National Register of Historic Places eligibility criteria (36 CFR 60.4) in consultation with our office.
