**1. Colorado Air Quality Challenges and Accomplishments over the Years**

The Commission and Division will discuss successful and unsuccessful efforts at reducing air pollution in order to meet Colorado’s air quality goals.

**2. Ozone Non-Attainment Planning Process**

The Commission will begin its discussions of the timelines and procedures for developing a State Implementation Plan to address the anticipated 8-hour ozone non-attainment designations for the Colorado Front Range. The Commission will solicit input from the Division, the Regional Air Quality Council and potentially other interested parties regarding how to best organize efforts to develop a new 8-hour Ozone SIP.

**3. Southern Ute Indian Reservation Air Quality Issues**

The Commission will meet with members of the Joint Southern Ute Indian Tribe/State of Colorado Environmental Commission, to discuss the work of the Joint Commission and air quality issues facing the Southern Ute Indian Reservation.

**4. Ozone and Southwest Colorado**

The Commission will discuss ozone issues facing Southwest Colorado, including the possibility of the area becoming non-attainment for ozone, and issues associated with developing an ozone State Implementation Plan for the area. Representatives from the Division, New Mexico Environment Department, and the WRAP will present information regarding ozone concentrations, ozone precursor sources and regional transport of ozone affecting the area. The Joint Southern Ute Indian Tribe/State of Colorado Environmental Commission is also invited to participate in these discussions.

## **5. Update on Southwest Colorado Air Quality Efforts**

Representatives from both the Four Corners Air Quality Forum and the Durango Train Smoke Mitigation Task Force will brief the Commission on their efforts over the past several years.
