1. Regulation Number 11, Parts A and C: Clean Screening

The Division will request the Commission set a rulemaking hearing to consider proposed changes to Regulation Number 11, Parts A and C, permitting government fleet-owned light duty vehicles to be clean screened.

PUBLIC HEARING

2. Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments (PPACG)

The Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments will present its 2035 *Moving Forward* Regional Transportation Plan and 2012-2017 Transportation Improvement Program. The PPACG has made an affirmative conformity determination for its Plan and TIP, and seeks AQCC concurrence with the findings.

3. Regulation Number 6, Part A

The Division will present to the Commission a proposal to revise Regulation Number 6, Part A (NSPS) to incorporate by reference changes the EPA made to its New Source Performance Standards rules.

This first briefing will likely focus on the considerations in designing an I/M Program, including a brief history of I/M programs in the U.S. and Colorado in particular, how evolving technology has shaped changes to I/M programs over time, and balancing emissions reductions with customer convenience.
