EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FOR OPERATOR CERTIFICATION WATER TREATMENT AND WATER DISTRIBUTION

What: \$230 reimbursement to cover certification costs for new and renewal operator certifications.

To Qualify:

- Application must be received by CDPHE within 6 months of date on operator certificate.
- Operator must work for a community or non-transient non-community water system serving fewer than 3,300 persons
- Grant applies to water treatment and water distribution certifications only – NOT wastewater

For faster turnaround, follow these instructions:

- ✓ Fill out the application form completely.
- ✓ Provide complete information on each certification, including operator ID, certification number, and date of certification.
- ✓ Have a system owner, manager, mayor, public works director, etc. sign the application – NOT the individual operator.
- ✓ Indicate to whom the check will be written.
- ✓ Provide a W-9 of individual to whom the check will be written.
- ✓ Deliver the application to CDPHE within 6 months of date on operator certificate.

Reimbursement applications must be **received by May 31, 2012**. No reimbursement requests received after that date will be accepted.
