- Attack problems or issues, not people



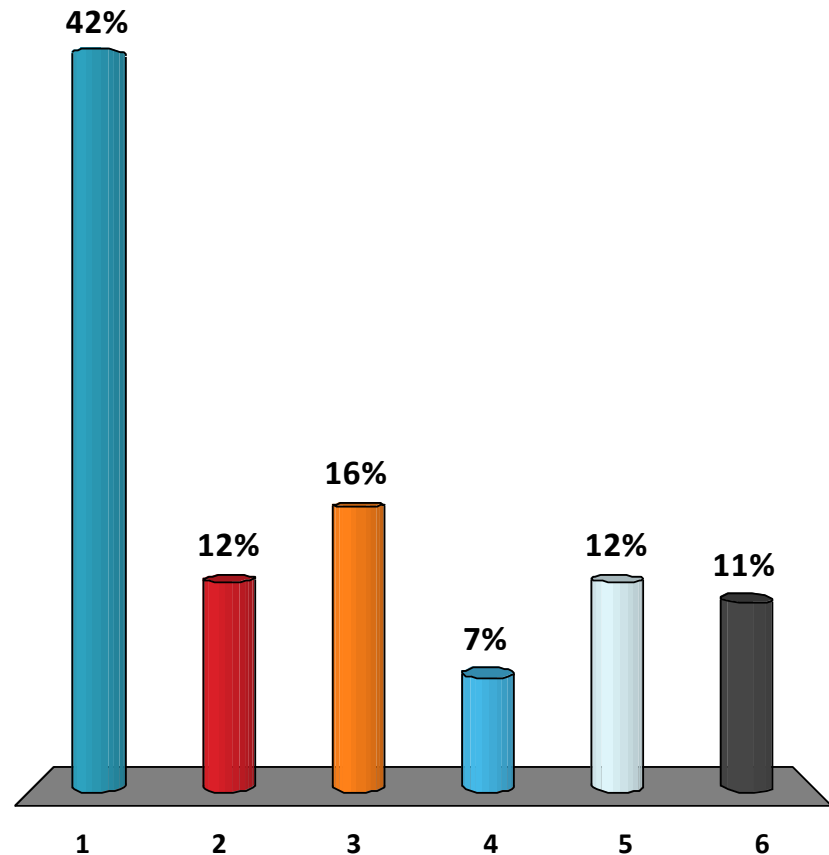
Use of the Audience Response Devices “Clickers”

- ▶ Your answers are anonymous.

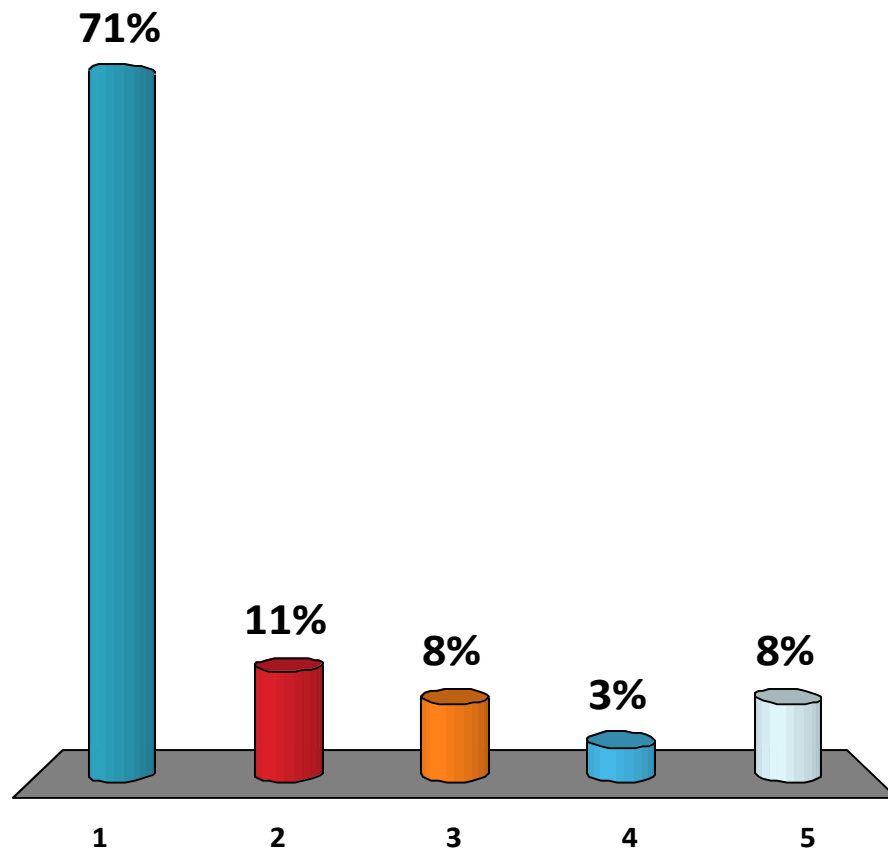

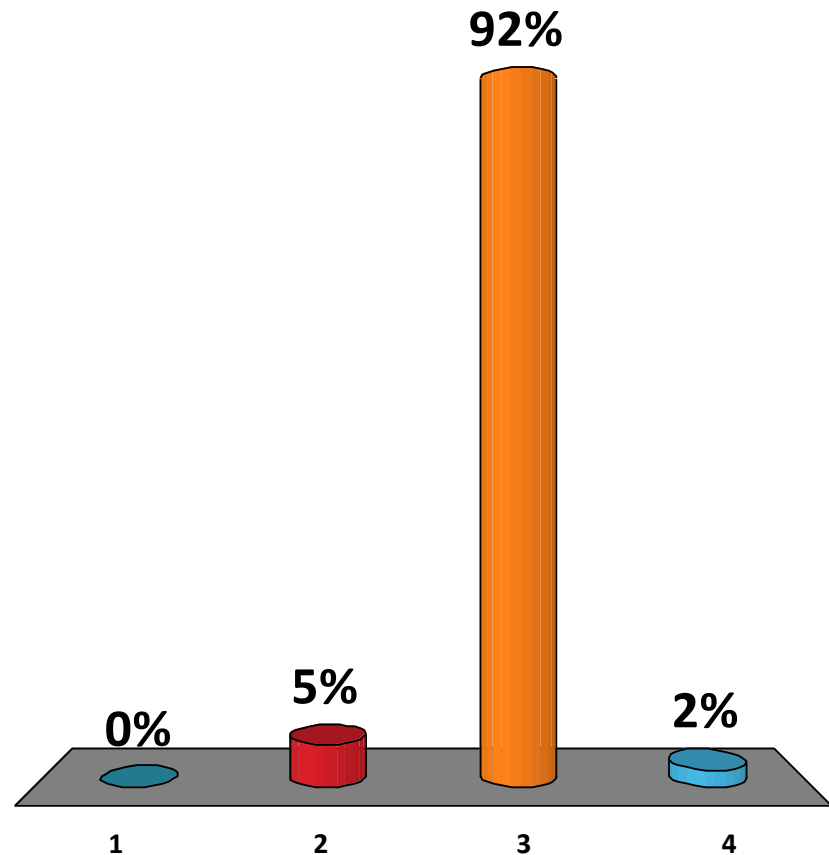

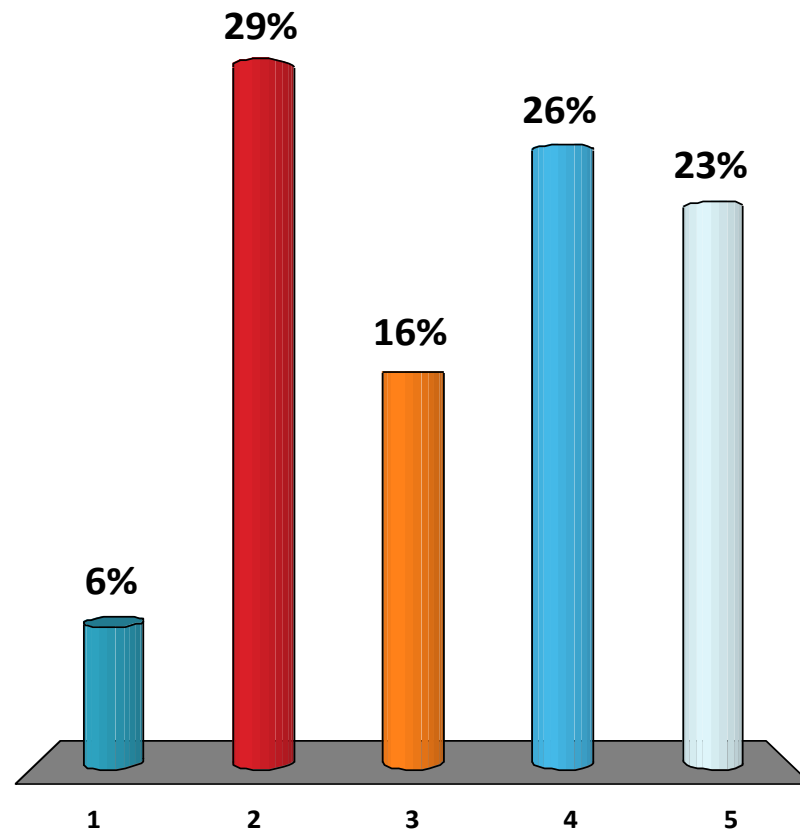
