

**FY 12 Colorado Children's Trust Fund

Questions & Answers**

**We are currently receiving Federal funds to support our Nurturing Parents class. We are interested in expanding the class to offer a second series in Spanish. Is this something that we could apply for CCTF funds for even though we are already receiving Federal funds for the same program?**

It is okay to apply for CCTF funding for your NP expansion to serve Spanish-speaking folks. You would not be disqualified because you are also receiving Federal funds for the other NP program.

**Does the narrative need to follow the "logic model" format (i.e., on page nine of the Request for Applications)?**

While the chart that starts on page nine of the RFA indicates the headings you should use and topics you should discuss in your narrative, it is not necessary (nor is it preferred) that you put these into a table format.

**Is it okay to include endnotes and would they be considered a part of the 6 pages? Also, can the narrative be single spaced?**

Endnotes are not typically counted as part of the page limit, if they are brief (i.e., less than one page).

While you can submit a single-spaced application, I would recommend 1 ½ space between lines for legibility's sake. Keep in mind that each reviewer will have about ten applications to read and you don't know what shape their eyes will be in when they get to your application!
