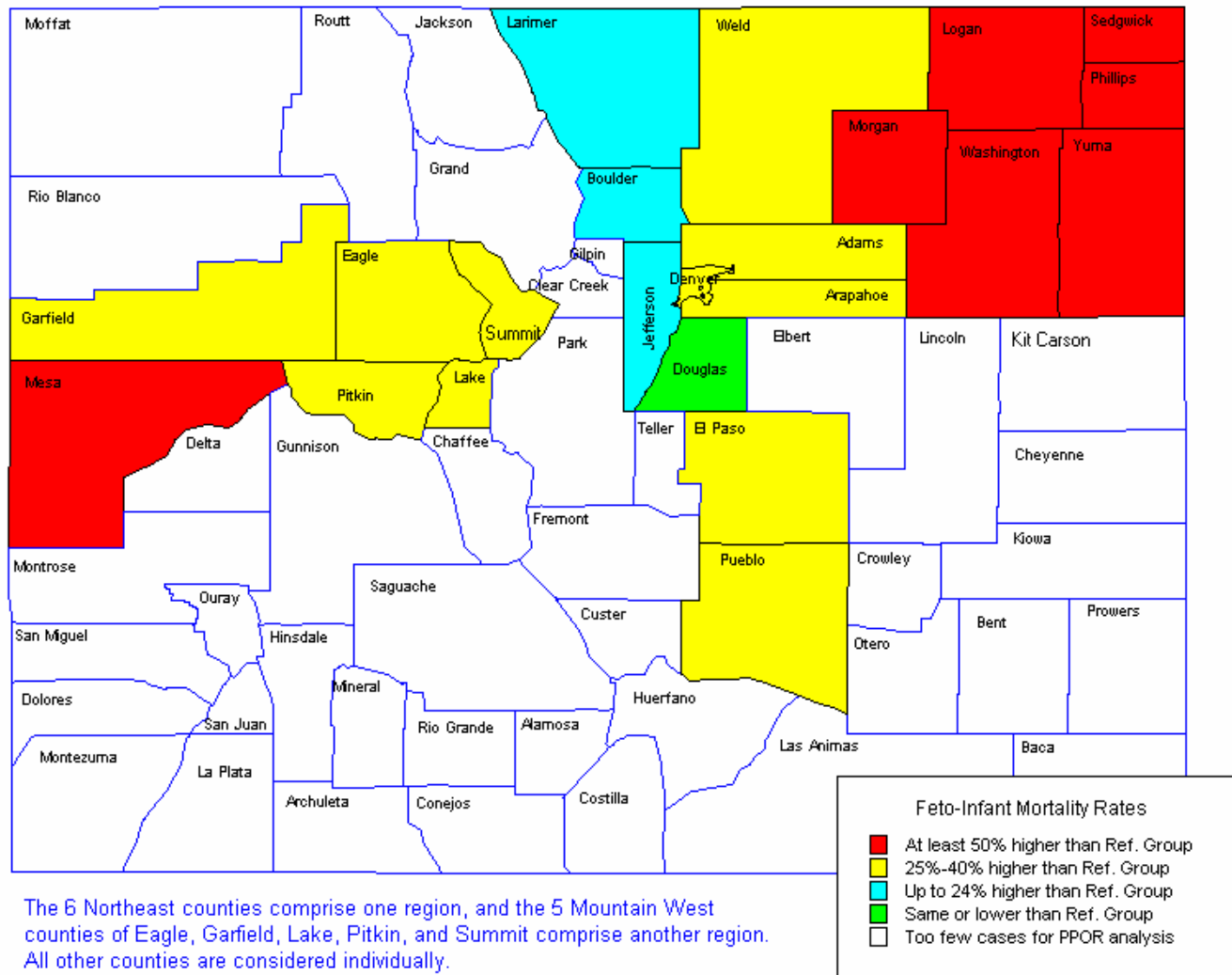

Maps of Colorado Perinatal Periods of Risk by County/Region

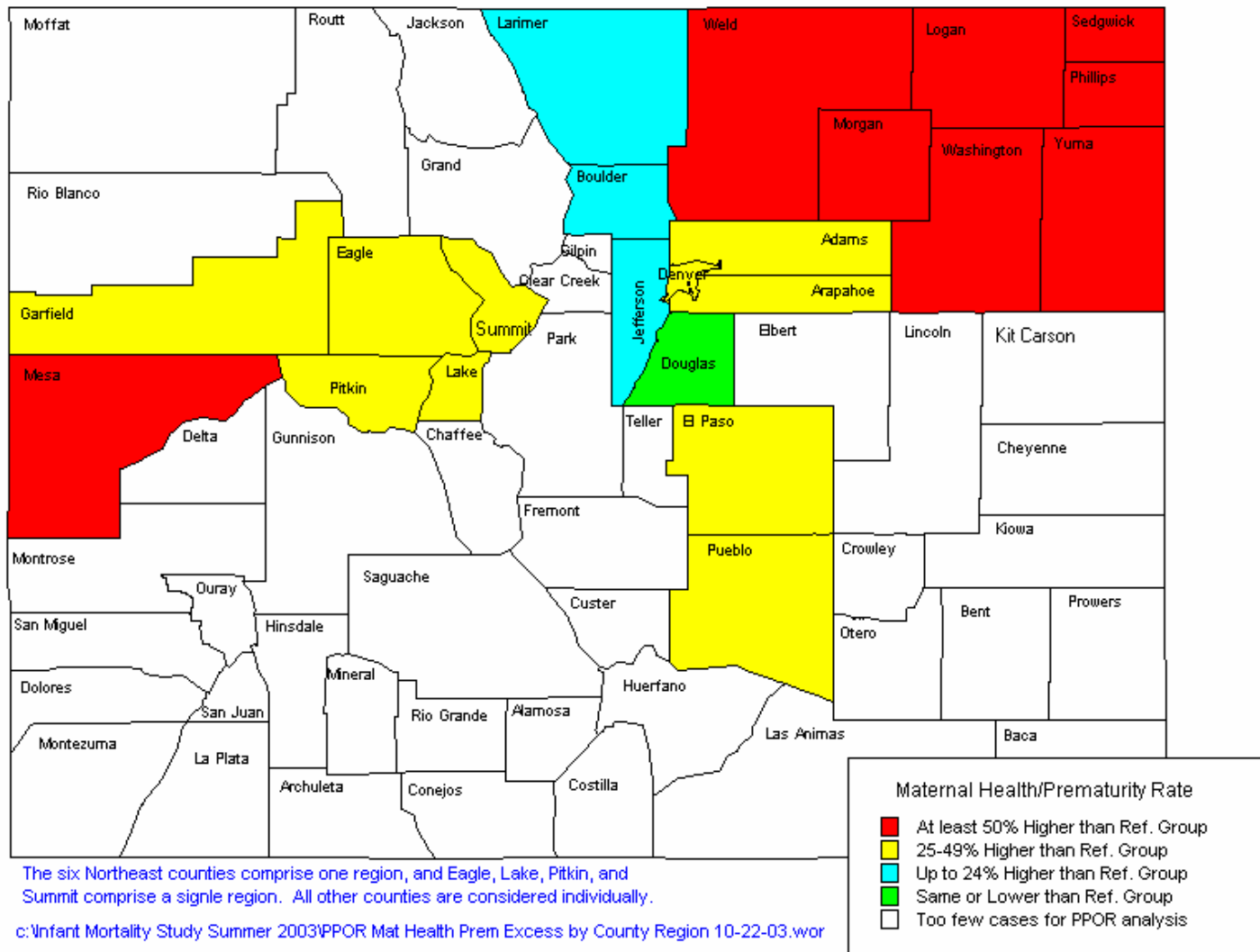
## Colorado Perinatal Periods of Risk Total Feto-Infant Mortality Rates by County or Region, 1997-2002

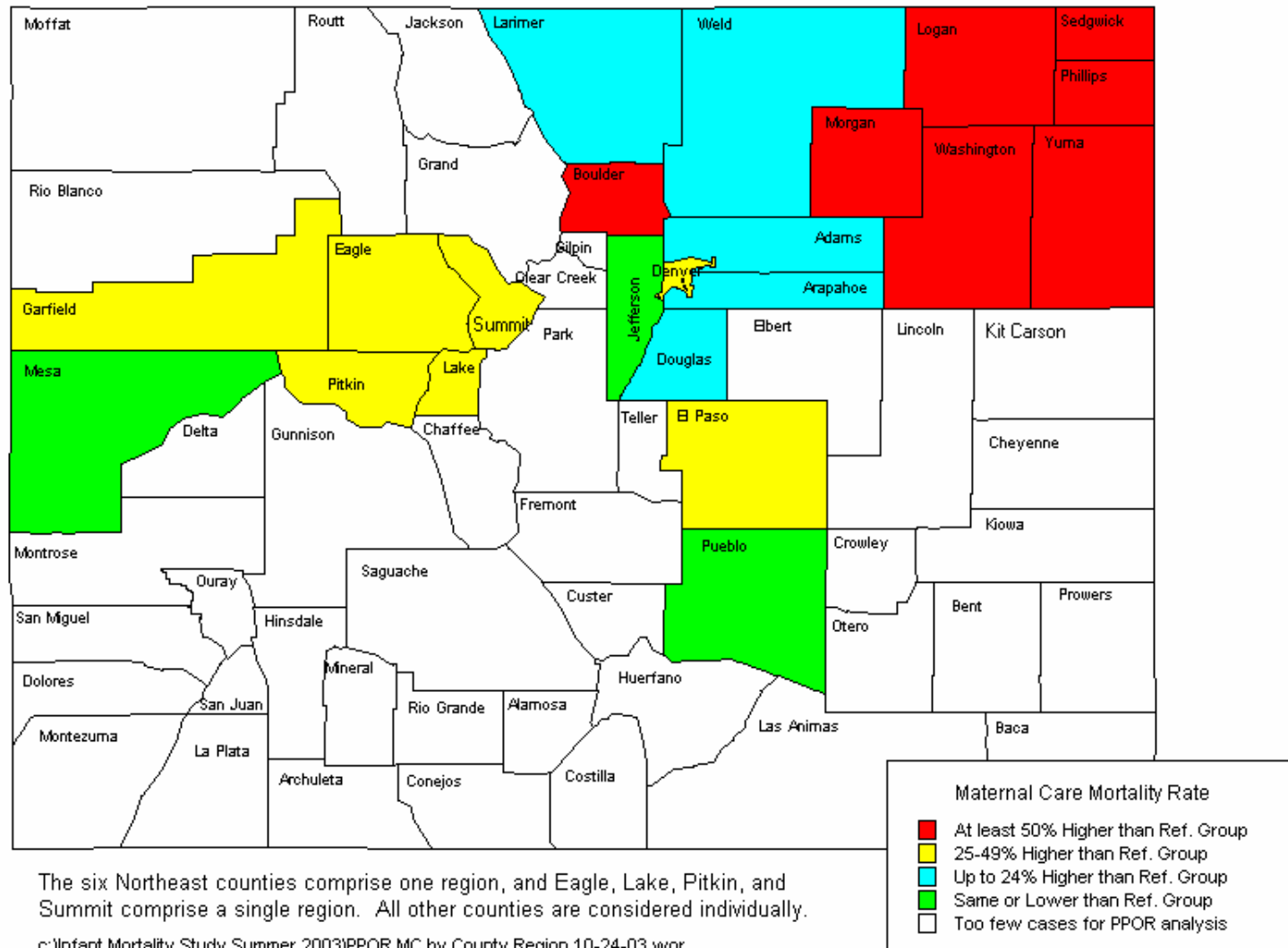

Maternal Care Mortality by County/Region, 1997-2002**

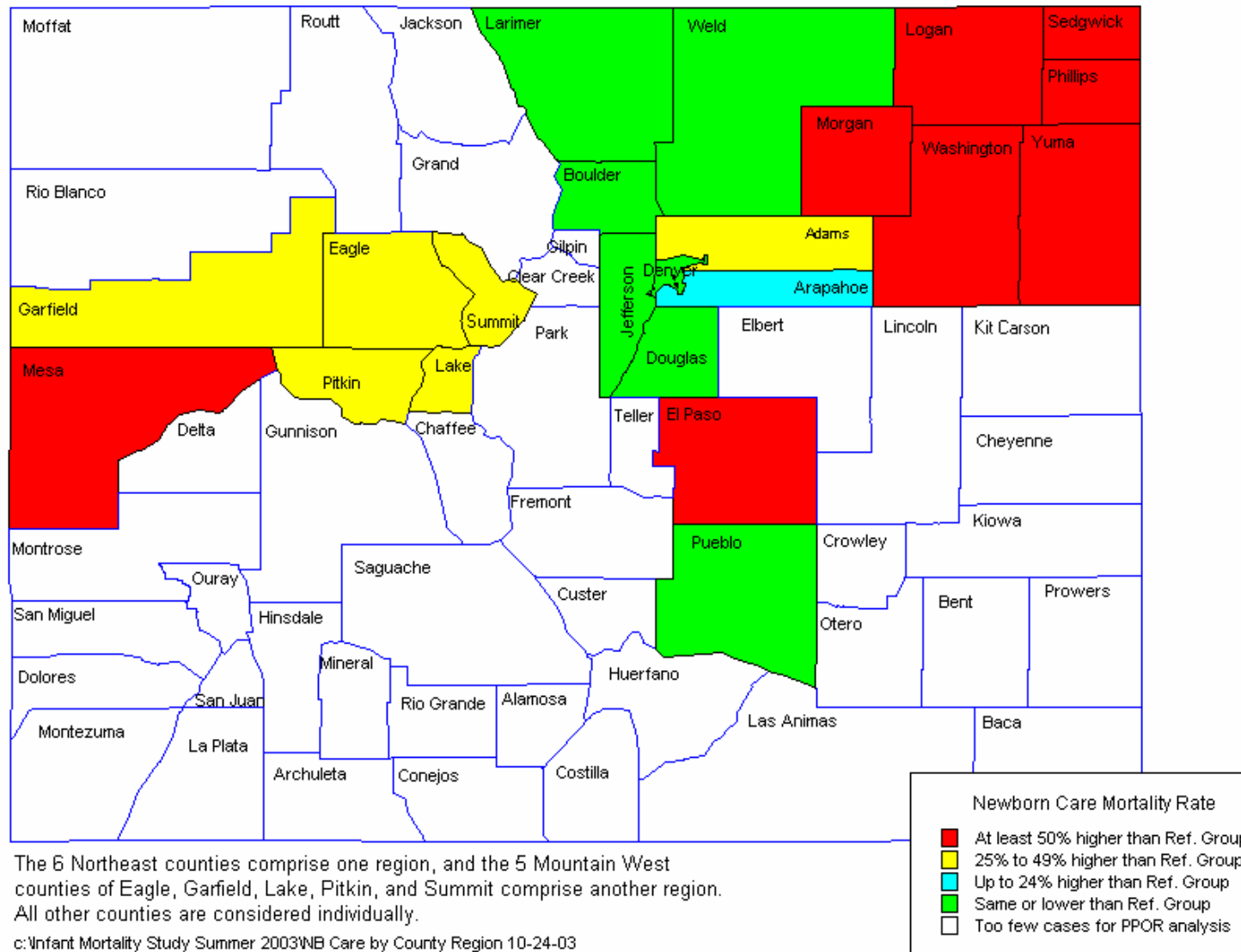

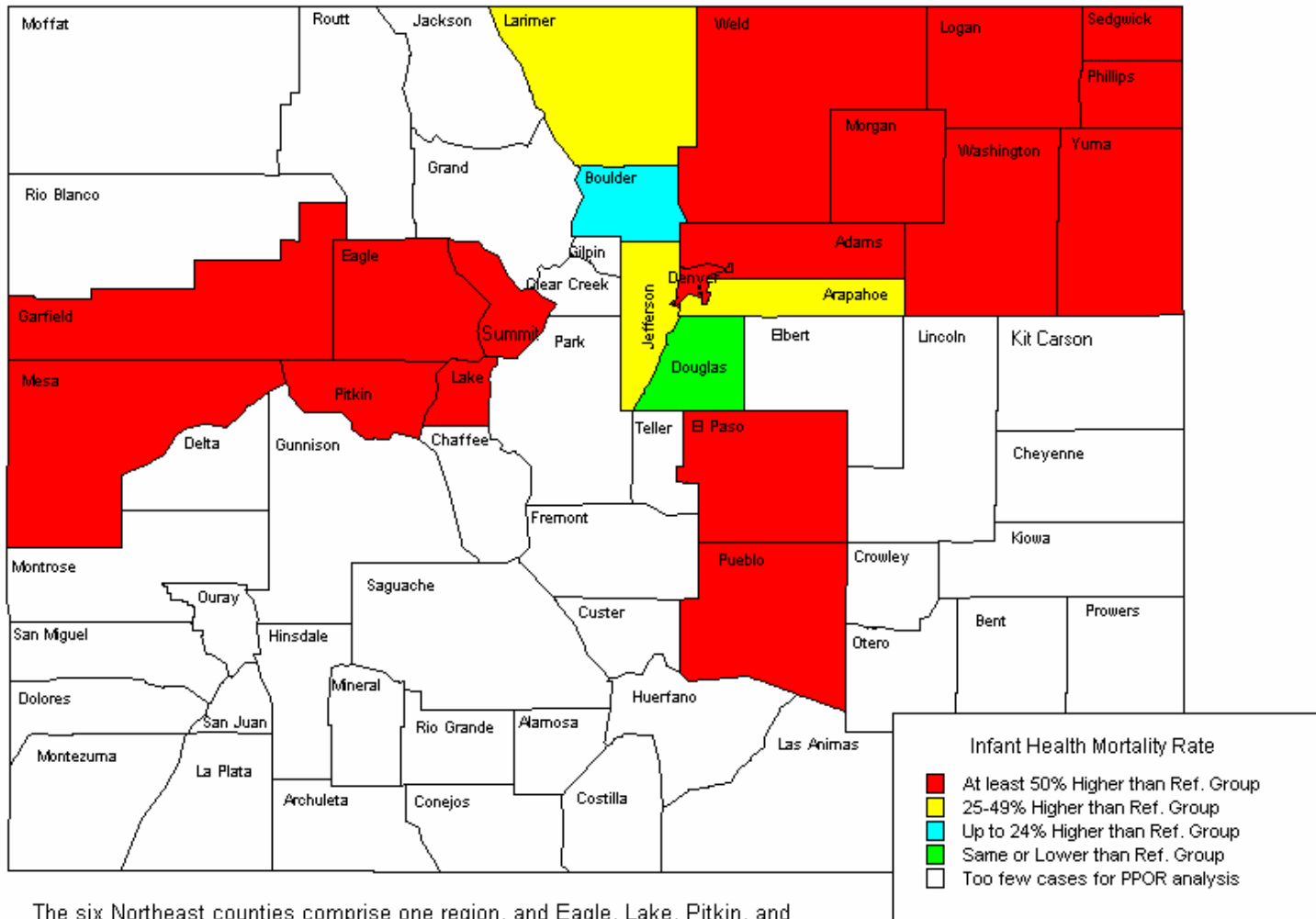
