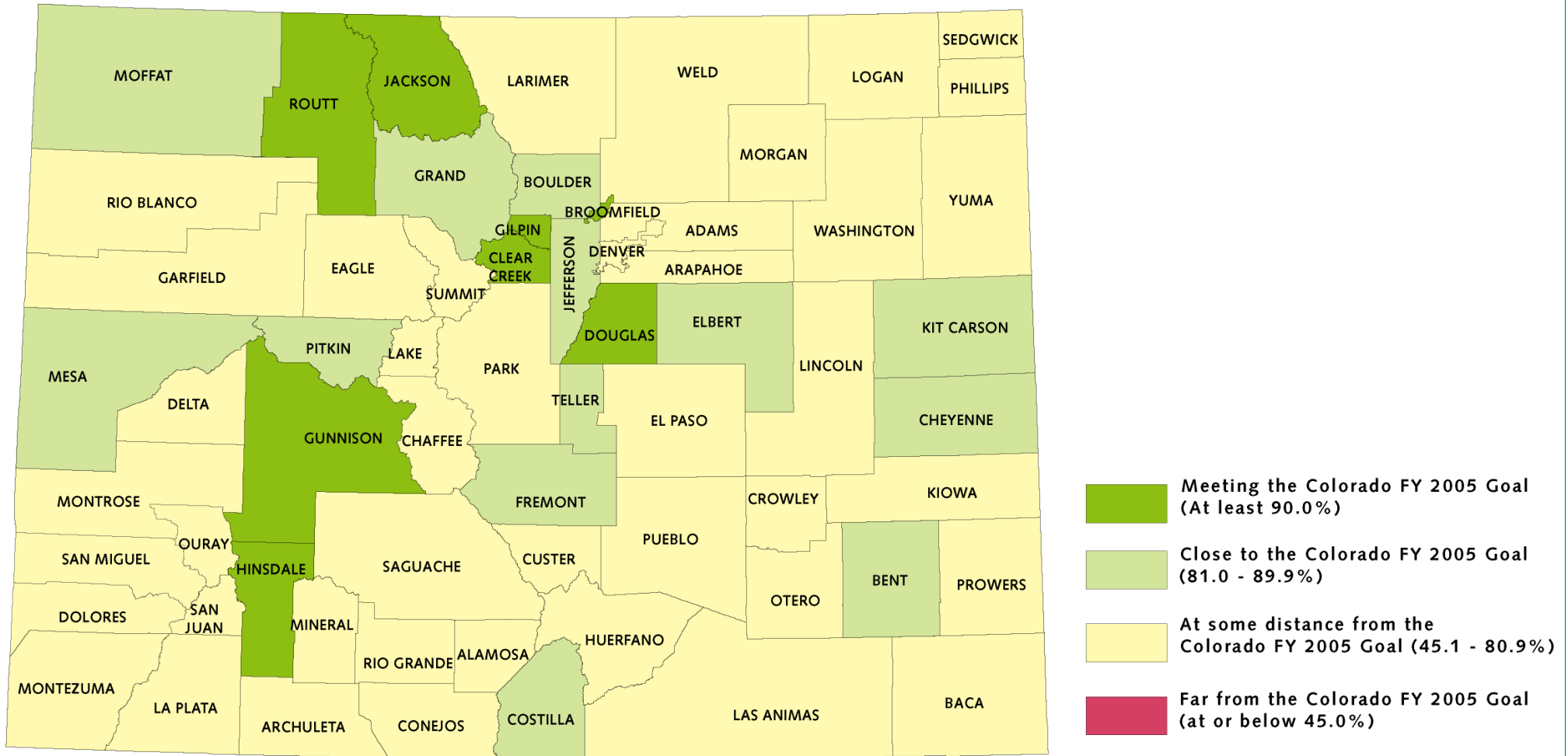


First Trimester Prenatal Care National Performance Measure 18

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Increase the percent of infants born to pregnant women receiving prenatal care beginning in the first trimester to 90.0 percent.*

County rates are for the year 2004. The state rate is 80.2 percent.
