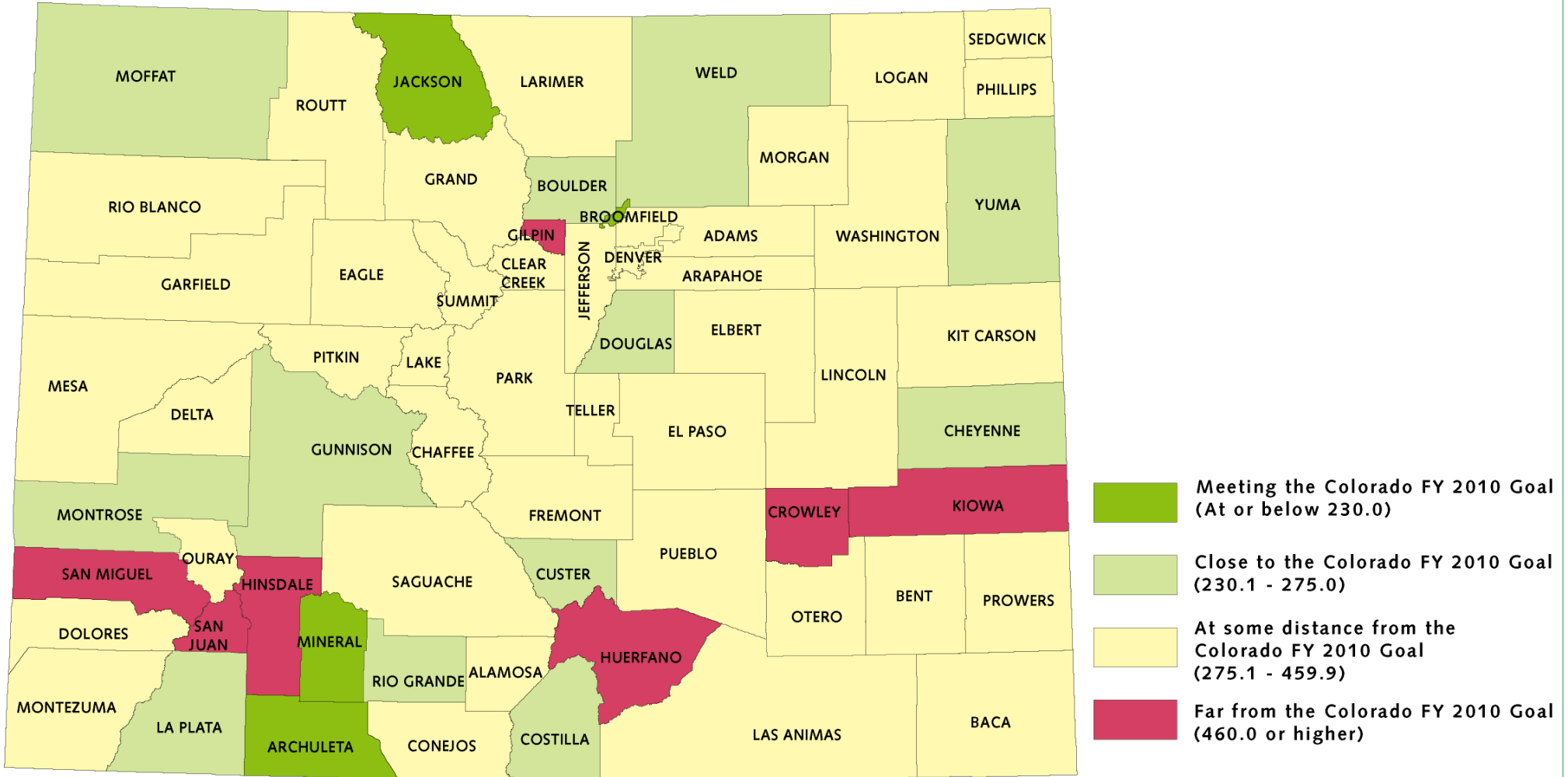


Injury Hospitalization Rate, Age 0-19

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: *Reduce the rate of injury hospitalization among children age 19 and younger to 230.0 per 100,000.*

County rates are 2000-2004 five-year averages. The Colorado rate is 299.8.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
