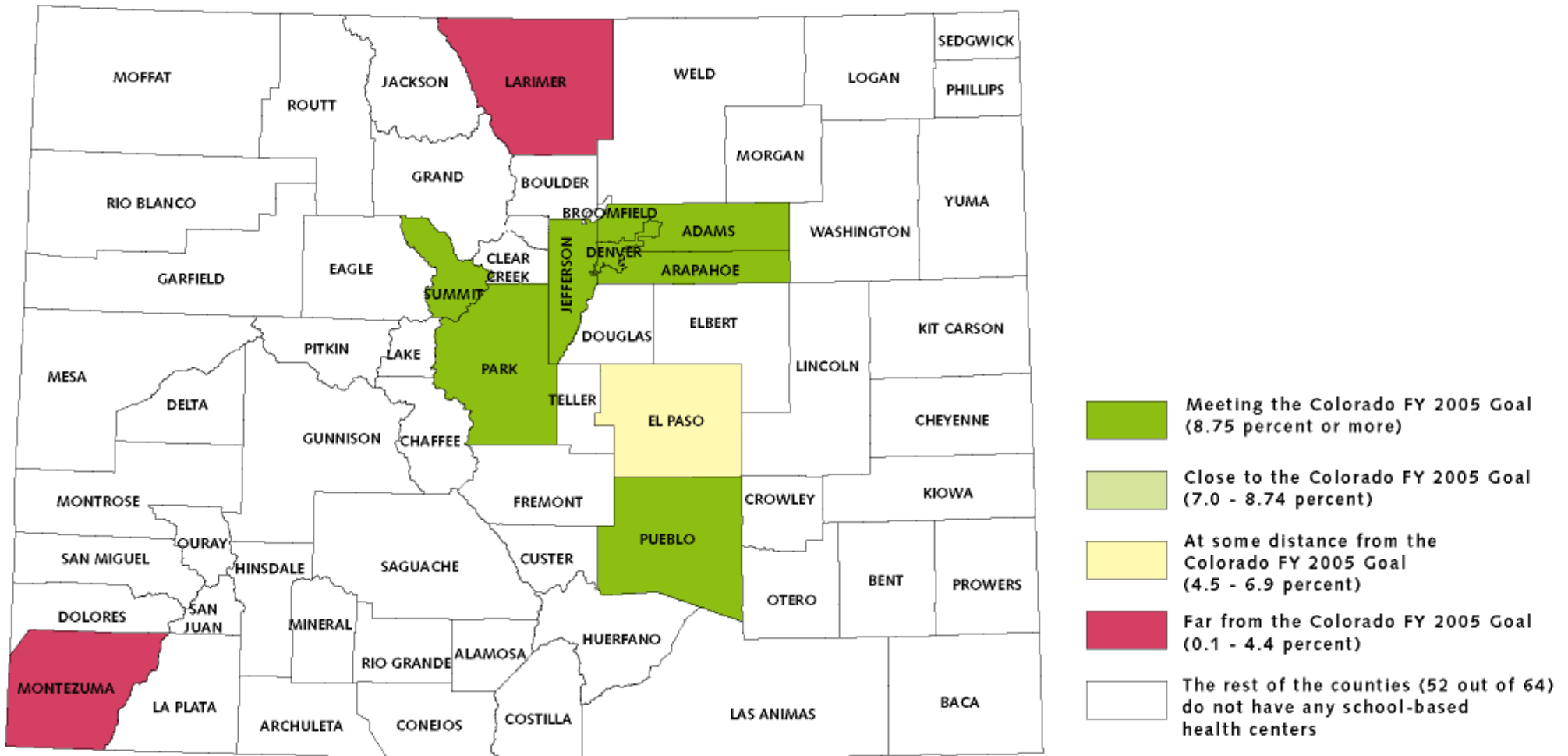


School-based Health Care (Percent) State Performance Measure 1

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: *Increase the proportion of children who have access to health services through school-based health centers to 15.0 percent statewide.*
