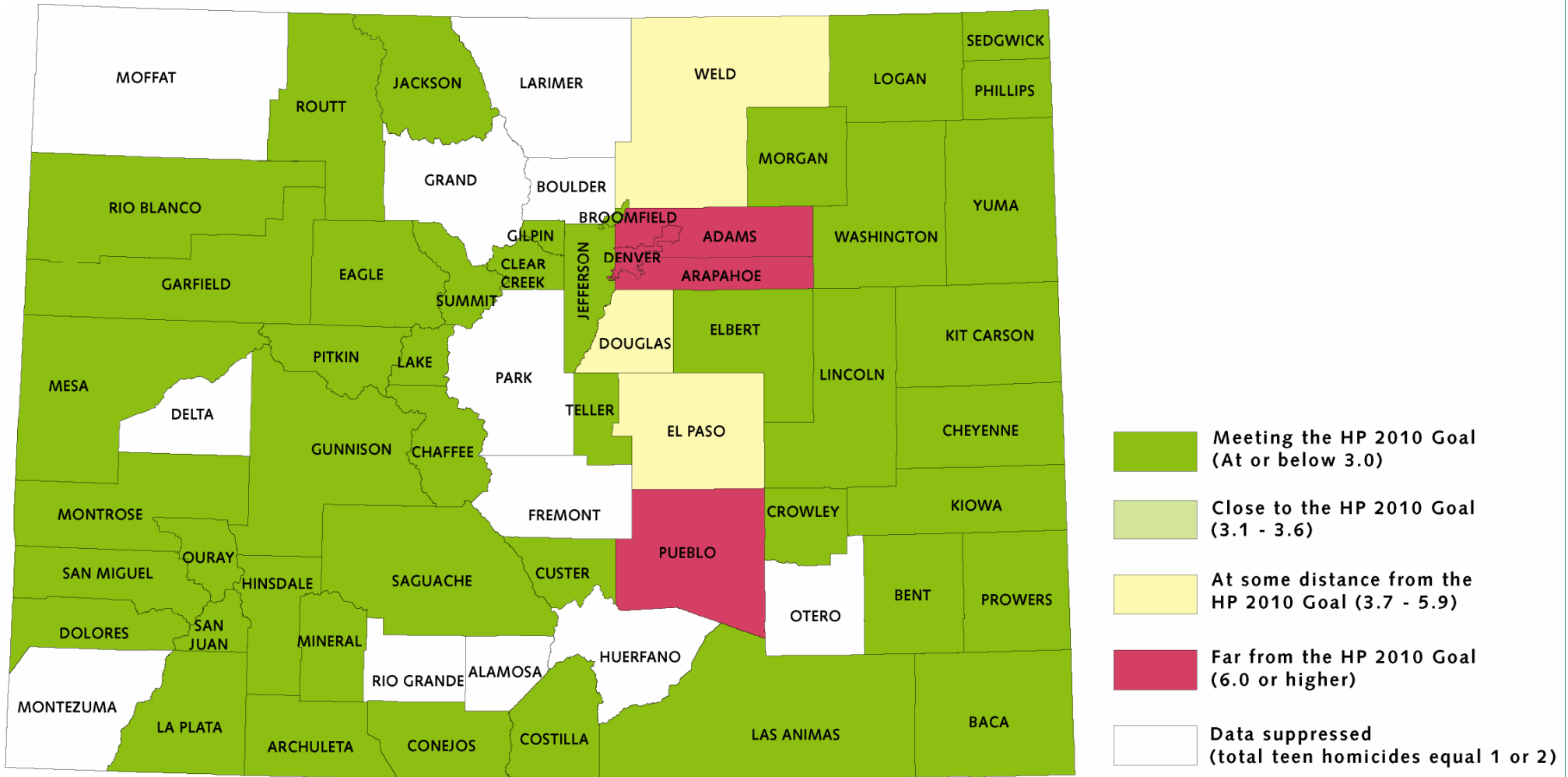


Teen Homicide 15-19

(Rate per 100,000)

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the teen homicide rate to no more than 3.0 per 100,000.

County rates are 2003-2007 five-year averages. The state rate is 5.6 per 100,000.



Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
