Annual Grant Application Budget requests are limited to a total maximum growth of 5% above the current year's grant award and are only awarded if funding is available and if the applicant is in good standing with an acceptable continuation application.

The Mid-year Budget Adjustment Process is intended for grantees to report unexpended funds, to request additional funds, or to request an adjustment within the current approved contract budget. Requests for additional funding are subject to CDPHE approval and can only be provided if funding is redistributed from other grantees reporting a savings. **NOTE:** In the budget category of Personal Services, requests for additional funding are restricted to fringe benefits only; base salary increases are not granted during the mid-year adjustment process.

NFPNSO Site Agreement Process is a separate annual contract between the NFPNSO and grantees specific to implementing the NFP program model. NFPNSO is the **NFP Training and Technical Assistance (T/TA)** provider. T/TA invoicing and payments are handled directly between the NFPNSO and grantees.

Note: The Nurse Home Visitor Program (NHVP) is the name of the grant administered by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to fund local agencies implementing the Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) model.
