**STATE BOARD OF HEALTH
Environmental Record Searches
(Adopted May 19, 1993, effective June 30, 1993)**

PART 1 ENVIRONMENTAL RECORD SEARCHES

1.1. Definitions.

For purpose of these regulations:

- (a) "Division" means the Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division.
- (b) "Environmental record search" means a search of environmental information and databases available to the Division concerning real property initiated by a requestor.
- (c) "Requestor" means a person or entity that has requested the Division to perform an environmental record search.

1.2 Fees Charged.

- (a) The Division may charge a requestor the actual reasonable costs incurred, not to exceed \$25.00 per hour for researching, reviewing and/or providing an environmental record search report. The Division shall bill the requestor by the quarter hour. In addition, the Division may charge the same fee for subsequent requests for the same or similar information. The fees in this subparagraph (a) may be waived or reduced by the Division if the information is to be used for a public purpose, including public agency program support, nonprofit activities, journalism or academic research.
- (b) The Division shall notify the requestor when the environmental record search report is complete and payment shall be made to the "Colorado Department of Health".
