Montrose County Comments on Environmental Report Section of Piñon Ridge Mill Radioactive Materials License Application

DENVER—The radiation program of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has received comments from the Montrose County Commissioners on the Environmental Report section of the Energy Fuels Resources Corp. radioactive materials license application. The license is required before the company can construct its proposed Piñon Ridge Uranium Mill about 12 miles west of Naturita, Colo., in the Paradox Valley. Receipt of the comments establishes a deadline of Jan. 17, 2011, for the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment to issue a decision on the license application.

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment will hold a public meeting to accept public comments and to discuss the ongoing licensing process, 6-9 p.m. Tuesday, June 8, at the Montrose Pavilion, 1800 Pavilion Dr. in Montrose.

State officials will make no public statements about the technical adequacy of the application during the review period.
