Grape tomatoes recall in Colorado expanded

DENVER— State health officials are warning consumers that additional products containing grape tomatoes supplied to Taylor Farms Pacific have been recalled due to possible Salmonella contamination.

The recalled tomatoes were used in packaged salads made by Taylor Farms Pacific for several retail stores. In Colorado, additional products sold at Safeway stores and King Soopers/City Markets (Kroger) are affected by the expanded recall at this time. According to both Safeway and Kroger representatives, all additional recalled products were pulled from Colorado store shelves. No illnesses have been reported to date.

The following additional Signature Café products sold at Safeway stores in Colorado are included in the recall:

- Shrimp Kabob with Vegetables in 1-pound styrofoam trays with use by dates of 4/26/2011-5/5/2011 and UPC code 023040700000
- Tuna Kabobs Fresh in 1-pound styrofoam trays, with use by dates of 4/26/2011-5/5/2011 and UPC Code 023040900000
- Halibut Kabob W/Veg., in 1- pound styrofoam trays with use by dates of 4/26/2011-5/5/2011 and UPC Code of 023040500000
- Salmon Atlantic Kabob, Marinated, in 1-pound styrofoam trays with use by dates of 4/26/2011-5/5/2011 and UPC Code of 023364000000
- Salmon Kabob w/Vegetables Fresh in 1-pound styrofoam trays with use by dates of 4/26/2011-5/5/2011 and UPC Code 023363900000

The following product sold at King Soopers and City Market Stores in Colorado also is included in the recall:

Individuals who may have purchased any of the recalled product(s) are advised to discard it or return it to the place of purchase for a refund.

Salmonella is a foodborne bacteria that can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy people infected with Salmonella often experience fever, diarrhea (which may be bloody), nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain.
